

# Back from trip?



## Green, orange or red zone?

There is no obligation when you return from a green zone. When returning from an orange zone, quarantine and testing is recommended. If you return from a red zone, you must be tested and quarantined for 14 days.



## Car, train, plane,...?

Two days before your return to Belgium, each family member fills in the digital PLF (PassengerLocator Form). This document is available via the following link:

## What's next?

After filling in the electronic PLF, you will receive a QR code. You present this code to the authorities as proof that you have completed this form.



## And after arriving in Belgium from a red zone?

Upon arrival from a red zone, you will immediately receive an SMS with a CPC code (Corona Test Prescription Code). This allows you to go directly to a collection center to be tested, without going to your doctor, unless you feel ill. ## Do I have to quarantine myself?

If you return from a red zone, a 14-day quarantine is mandatory. Even with a negative test result. This is drastic, but it protects your family and friends. Even if you have no symptoms, you remain a high-risk contact and should avoid spreading the virus.
